Ideal Start Date:

September 2014 (Round 1) OR December 2014 (Round 2)

Key Roles and Responsibilities:

- **Sponsor communication:** Girls in our Dream Home can be sponsored by supporters. Responsible for reading through blog posts from donors and obtaining stories from clients to post on the blog in return each week. You'll collect updates on each sponsored girl two times per year.
- **English Teaching:** Responsible for regular and ad hoc English tutoring for individuals and groups of clients. You'll provide cover for full time English teachers when they are away, create tutoring lesson plans and ensure client progress in English learning.
- **Newsletter Stories:** Responsible for developing two newsletter stories each month.
- **Social Media:** The intern will work in conjunction with the Director of Survivor Care Support to utilize social media to further the work of Hope for Justice.
- **Communications Projects:** Will work with Director of Survivor Care Support on any new or in progress communication projects for the organization.
- **Holiday Activities:** During public holidays, the intern will be expected to help with client activities as determined by the Field Director.
- **Volunteer Liaison:** Key contact person for all potential volunteers. This includes email and/or Skype communication; continued expansion and improvement of volunteer materials; and logistical assistance for new volunteers when they arrive in Cambodia.

Ideal Candidate:

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Bachelor Degree in Communications, Journalism, Sociology, Education or related field.
- Understanding of various forms of social media (including Facebook, Instagram, Pinterest, Twitter, and blogging).
- Experience working with trauma survivors or vulnerable populations.
- Overseas work or volunteer experience. Experience in cross-cultural work environments is desirable.
- Native-level English Speaker.
- Understanding of Cambodian history and current issues is desirable.
- Self-starter, creative, able to work independently.
