MODERN SLAVERY AWARENESS Resources, learning pathways, customer feedback and contact us

<u>UK ELEARNING : KNOW IT, SEE IT, AND RESPOND TO IT</u>

Our online training course at the Hope for Justice Learning Academy portal can be taken in your own time. <u>This course is aimed at the general public</u> and anyone who wants to learn more about the prevalence of modern slavery and human trafficking in the UK and the steps they can take to prevent and report these crimes. It can also be used as part of our professionals resource.

VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

The 3 hour live interactive session is suitable for professionals (and volunteers) who may work with or may identify potential victims of modern slavery. <u>This classroom</u> contains content from the above elearning. If you prefer to pace your learning and devote less to the live time session, opt for one of the other learning pathways below.

Learning outcomes

- Explain what modern slavery is and identify the different types that exist;
- Recognise the signs and indicators of the different types of modern slavery;
- Respond appropriately if a victim of modern slavery is identified;

COMMUNITY AND MULTIAGENCY LEARNING PATHWAY

This pathway addresses the same learning as above but **<u>the learning emphasis is on</u>** identification

Your learning starts by completing the eLearning. This prepares you to engage effectively in the 90 mins live session where the spot the signs are explored further. This enhances your skills of identification when engaging with others from the community and statutory agencies.

Further learning is offered where there is a 60 min total of online training resources to complete your learning that matches your training needs. These include Frequently asked Questions, Legislation overview and procedures. This is set at your own pace.

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING PATHWAY

This pathway addresses the same learning as above but <u>the learning emphasis is</u> on trama-informed response.

It is suitable for first responders, professionals and those supporting first responders who may come into contact with potential victims of modern slavery and human trafficking. Your learning starts by completing the eLearning and selected modules about the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) and the principles of a trauma-informed response.

This prepares you to engage effectively in the 60 mins live session where a staged case study of a potential victim explores how you respond. This enhances your trauma-informed response skills in the context of legislative measures, such as the NRM.

Further learning is offered where you can select online training resources to match your learning needs, set at your own pace.


